ground about ten cubits, and which was just big enough to circumscribe the crystal bubble in which I sat.

28. And now, I did also notice upon approaching it, that there were eight crystals inbedded in the alabaster ring, equa-distant from one another. And now the colors of these crystals, which were round and smooth, was on the top, Cyan, top left Green, left Yellow, bottom left Orange, bottom Red, bottom right Violet, right Purple, top right Blue.

31. Now, I did realize that perhaps I did need to write the current names of the Lambs. Wherefore I wrote, Luz, and behold, the bottom Red one did light up! And thus I did begin, Bensidon, and the Blue one lit up, Nebo, and the Orange one lit up, Eldrid, and the Green one lit up; but then I was again much perplexed!

32. I, did finally entertain Garthanah's words, and wrote, Mananiah, and the Purple one lit up! And now, I did contemplate much, for the Yellow, and Violet crystals were still dark.

33. Now, I did think of Barak, even though we disagreed upon many points of doctrine, but I did feel good about him in mine heart, wherefore, I typed, Barak, and verily the violet one lit up! But behold, I was now out of names, so I tried, Jurubeal, Reaia, Ramziah, I even tried Baal, and Vivishath, to no avail.

Therefore, I truly feared that I was on the stump for good!

34. I looketh at the peacock, who kood again. Then I did have an inspiration! I did write, Adadonus, and the final Yellow one lit up!

35. Now verily, the sight in the ring did change insomuch that it did look like the stars of night within it, and the crystal ephah did fly into it with great speed!

Chapter Twenty Four:

Behold, when the bubble I was in did fly into the ring, I did find mine self in a new place, which was indescribably amazing.

2. Yea, there was a sea, but this sea did end abruptly upon the edge of a huge, and much bigger translucent crystal bubble. 10. Whereupon, she saith, do ye verily believe that ye met a peacock, and a salamander, and a giant hairy female Nephilim?

And now, she did begin to laugh! - and did say, that would be crazy! Wherefore she did continue to laugh a little.

11. And I Mananiah saith, Garthanah? And she saith, Yea, I am Garthanah. Now, I saith, How? Whereupon, she saith, The Gods are verily Shapeshifters, or lo, how else would the angel who spoke unto Sampson's parents turn into a flaming bird?

12. Now, I Mananiah saith, I hadn't thought of that.

13. And now, Garthanah came forth, and did hug me, and saith, I love thee, Mananiah! Behold, we did it, we found the oasis of Tishbe! I saith, Oasis? - I thought ye meant some water and tents in the desert. Garthanah saith, Nay, I meant an Oasis in space! I shall tell thee more, but let us explore.

14. And now, it came to pass, that we did go up the pathway unto the small marble building, which had eight sides and a fifty degree pointed roof.

15. And, lo, when we did go and enter it, we found an altar with some more buttons; and also shelves of books, on six of the eight walls.

16. And now, I Mananiah, did see a glowing button which did say the word, message, in glowing light, wherefore I did push it.

17. Now an image of a man did appear, made of light, and lo, he was dressed all in white, yea, he even did have white trousers and socks; and he did look bright and glorious, and white.

18. And now, the man, made of light, upon the altar, did address Garthanah, and I; and now, he did say, Behold, this is only a recorded message, using this advanced crystal device, wherefore I am not truly before thee; although I am always with thee, even now.

19. For behold, the time hath not yet come to manifest mine self unto mine people, for I am Benbanuh, the Messiah, the savior of the world. And lo, I am with thee, even watching this very message, but the time hath not yet come, but by and by, I come quickly! I am Alpha and Omega the beginning and the end.

20. And now behold, ye have come unto this ship of the Gods, but lo, thy work is not finished, for ye must decipher the puzzles upon the ship; and when ye hath deciphered all the ships secrets ye shall gain power over all the ships abilities; wherefore, be thou sober, and full of love, and charity for all men.

21. And behold, I give thee the first puzzle, for it would take thee much time and study to unlock it, therefore, be of good cheer, for I give it thee, and that is, to have the authority to use the

23. I take this Oath, and Covenant, upon myself as a servant and Knight of Benbanuh, and of his word, which is a two edged crystal blade; and I do this in the name of Hayah, and of Benbanuh, and of Shiloh, letting the water, the blood, and the spirit be mine witnesses before Angels; Amen!

24. And now, behold, I love thee, and am thy advocate with the Father, Hayah; therefore, love one another, and give each other grace, that ye might receive grace, and receive ye the Love of God, which he sheddeth forth upon all those who are just and true.

And now, I come quickly to take vengeance upon the wicked, and to lead thee by pure waters, and give thee all the blessings of Eternal Life; even of, virtue, and virgins, and crystal cities, and of powers, and dominions, and servants, and families, and of all joys and good; for I shall sing thy praise in the congregation!

25. Wherefore, rejoice mine little children, for the kingdom is yours.

Even, so, Amen!

26. And now, the image of light, which was a record of Benbanuh did vanish, and Garthanah and I did both take the Oath and Covenant of the Priesthood upon us, and we did rejoice gratefully at receiving this precious revelation from Benbanuh.

Chapter Twenty Five:

1. Now, lo, I did look about, at the other buttons upon the pedestal, and verily there were six round buttons which were orb-like; yea, and each of them had much detail in them, and did look like planets, or moons.

7. But lo, Garthanah saith, Mananiah, I do not know if we are able yet.

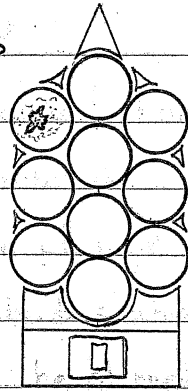
8. Wherefore, I did run back down the pathway, unto the crystal ephah, and Garthanah did follow after me, close behind.

13. Now Garthanah saith, lo, I thinketh that it is a map of the ship. Behold, look off in the distance, see ye beyond that crystal dome, to the left, how there is a crystal glass there that looketh like the edge of a triangle?

14. Whereupon I saith, Yea, ye mean, the circle to the top right of us, is that top crystal dome, beyond which we can see the edge of a crystal triangle, while we are looking to our left: For behold, we were facing East as it pertaineth unto the ship. She saith, Yea, if we face the forward of the ship, to our right, beyond that dome.

15. Now, I did behold it, and did say, Oh Garthanah, but how do we get to the display that controls the alabaster ring?

18. Wherefore, Garthanah saith, fear not Mananiah! For behold, Hayah is mindful of us, and yea, Benbanuh is even with us, according unto his word in his message of light. For again, think ye that we would have gotten unto this ship if it were not a part of God's plan? And verily, he planneth only good for us; lo, his hand is in all things.

19. And behold, if members of thy family perish, then verily they are Lambs before God, and how much greater the glory! And ye even know that one of them is literally one of Benbanuh's seven Lambs, for ye did write his name into the diagraph of light which got us here, and brought us forth unto this ship, therefore how can ye fear at all?

20. But lo, I Mananiah saith, Verily, verily, I am not worried for Adadonus, for he is with Barak, and I worry not for Ashsuh, she is with mine kin; verily I fear exceedingly for mine true love Yael! For lo, and behold, she is espoused to marry Baal, her own father, after the days of her purification is fulfilled; and verily, judging upon about when Adadonus did lay with her, and also safely judging, we have, only about fifty nine days remaining!

21. And now, I did begin to weep; Wherefore, Garthanah did say, Mananiah, then we must simply solve these puzzles, in the next fifty eight days.

22. Whereupon, I Mananiah, did say, But, lo, she must certainly

be mine Iuh counterpart! I cannot live in Eternity without her.

23. Garthanah saith, If that be so, then she will not be defiled, therefore rejoice! And now, how do ye know that she is thy Iuh counterpart?

24. I saith, I love her, therefore I feel that I am; but lo, why did Hayah send her unto Baal to be his daughter?

25. And now, Garthanah saith, Behold, the Lord hath a plan for all his children, and his hand is in all things; wherefore all his children must choose for themselves, whether they be male, or female. But behold, as one who is sealed up unto Eternal Life, Hayah knoweth what thy Iuh counterpart shall choose, and according unto his plan in all things, she cannot be defiled, nor cease to be an Eternal virgine, in Eternity, according unto his word.

26. Therefore if Yael be defiled, then she is a servant, and not one of thy seven celestial wives, for the lord thy God hath spoken it!

27. And now, I did say, Oh Garthanah, verily, ye art a shape-shifting God, therefore, ye know nothing about this ship? For lo, ye also knew that it was an Oasis in space, and ye said that ye know the sheiks of Tishbe, so do ye not know how to solve all these puzzles? Forgive me for questioning thee!

28. Now, Garthanah saith, Nay; verily I have the power to shape-shift, because I am translated. But behold, translated beings don't know everything! Yea, we know that which we learn

just like thee, for we do not gain access unto all knowledge until well after we are resurrected; yea, we will be all knowing when we become exalted Gods, in the highest degree of the Celestial kingdom.

Chapter Twenty Six:

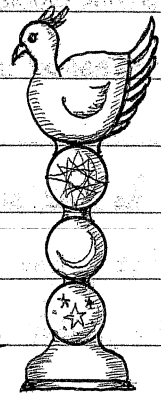

8. Yea, verily, this is why the dead man who landed upon Elisha's bones did revive. And, yea, it is also why Israel, and Joseph did make their children swear to take their bones unto the cave of Macpelah, where Abraham and Isaac were; for verily they did attain unto translation before they did die. And now, Macpelah is where they could be safely stored because there is a portal in that cave unto the Perfumed Garden of the Lord, even unto Eden, where the Gods did live the Holy Order.

9. Now, this is also why Michael did claim the bones of Moses; for lo, the mechanisms of translation do reside in the bones.

10. Furthermore, this is why translated beings can be shape-shifters, because the tiny crystal mechanisms come out of the bones, transforming the flesh, but also making the bones fluid.

11. And now, I lead thee unto the grave of Sheba, the son of Abihail, already knowing of it's location; because I did verily eat one of his bones, according unto the word of mine father, who did know him.

12. Whereupon I Mananiah, did say, What? Ye ate one of his bones?

13. And now, Garthanah did say, Yea, according unto the instruction of mine father, and verily, the age ye see me now, is the age I was when I ate it. For mine father wished to preserve me as I was; and after he did die of old age, I did go into the wilderness, for I could not explain these things unto anyone else.

14. Wherefore, remembering that mine father said, that the Lambs would return, I did wait; and did commune with God in the wilderness, and did receive much marvelous revelation, according unto the tender mercies of the Lord; and now I did keep mine self pure, and did meditate upon the things of God for the space of seventy years.

15. Now I did cry out, and did say, Oh mine dear child! And verily, I did hug her, for I knew not anything concerning these things.

16. And behold, we did see that the paintings were of animals, of a phoenix, a fish or serpent, a hippopotamus calf, and also animals entering the ark of Noah, and Azaspion's ark, who is the same Lamb.

17. Now, we also did see two panels like tablets, upon the front side, of the pedistal, upon which was the image of the cock.

18. And lo, these panels did have writing upon them, and now

this is the writing which was upon them:

19. Thou shalt be espoused unto a virgin, and shalt espouse virgins unto those who have not yet been espoused unto a virgin, and shalt look humbly upon those who have not as of yet been espoused unto a virgin, and preserve virtue for them.

20. Thou shalt share those wives who did not have virtue, with one another; and shalt have love one for another, and shalt live polyandry where there is no virtue, but also where ye did receive virtue after some time of receiving it, as ye will.

21. Thou shalt live the Holy Order of the Ancients wherein ye all work as a family, and wherein ye all lay with all, and all sleep with all, wherever there is great brotherly love!

22. Thou shalt do justice unto all. Thou shalt not steal, and thou shalt especially not steal virtue, or life, or great substance, or freedom.

23. Thou shalt not steal the day of rest from any of thy laborers, hirelings, servants, or slaves; nor shalt thou take anyone's offering unto the Gods, or eat their offering, or drink their oblation, or take anything that they dedicate unto God unjustly; nor shalt thou tell another how to relax upon their day of rest; I am the Lord of the day of rest, and I shall whisper into their hearts that which will be restful for them.

24. If there be a god who saith that he only doeth good, and that he doeth no evil, and that the devil, or Satan, doeth evil, but that he doeth just good, that god is a false god; and is not even a servant in the Celestial Kingdom! For I Hayah doeth all things, both good, and evil; and verily I am all thine evil, and all thine good, in all thine lives.

25. If there be a god who saith that he is jealous, when ye have only sought me, but he saith he is jealous of thee, that god, is a false god! That god is jealous because he knoweth that there are gods higher than him, and he lusteth after those who belongeth unto me, and unto the Gods. In all my people's creativity and imagining I see them feeling after me; I am the pleasure in their copulation, I am their imagination!

26. If a god saith that ye have been unfaithful while feeling after me, that god is a false god! A husband doth not leave his wife comfortless and than sayeth that she is unfaithful. Ye know that I have been in you, and those who have not felt mine presence never will, even though I shall shed forth gifts.

27. If a god saith that he wants to bless you, but you need to ask first, that god is a false god! I know what ye have need of, and I will give thee everything in its time.

28. Do not interrupt thine enjoyment to thank me, but thank me in the enjoyment, for I experience what ye experience, I am thine pleasure!

29. And now, it came to pass, that Garthanah saith, Behold, the tablets of the law that Moses broke! Wherefore, I Mananiah saith, the tablets that Moses broke said something different from the ones we have been told about?

30. Now Garthanah saith, Yea, certainly! For Moses broke the higher law which wast taken away; and even the lower law hath been altered by the children of Judah, or else there would not be so much confusion about the nature of God, his attributes, and his character.

31. For behold, the children of Judah saith that fallen angels came down before the flood and mated with the daughters of men, making Nephilim.

32. But behold, nothing could be further from the truth, for lo, we, the children of Naphtali, Gad, Reuben, and Issachar, have indipendantly passed down the truth among us.

33. And now, the truth is, that the sons of God were the righteous who did live in a mountain, and who were taken up into heaven, in the days of Enoch; for they were Zion, even of one heart; and lo, it was some of their daughters who did mate with the children of men, who were wicked. Wherefore, the children of Judah did truly turn all things upon their head, and did call evil good, and good evil.

Chapter Twenty Seven:

¶ 1. And behold, Garthanah, and I, did go outside, and did

See that the great planet-like sun, with clouds, which doth have a red glow, was going down below the horizon of the dome; for the whole ship was rotating slowly in space.

4. Now, I saith, Nay, for I look not much different than you did as a Nephilim, big and hairy, only worse being male. And thereupon Garthanah saith, Do not speak such blasphemy, for ye are perfect, just as ye are created; how could I love God if I dislike hair? I appeared before thee as a hairy Nephilim, and ye will appear before me as a fine man, just as soon as we find a place for you to store those frivelous acutriments!

5. Behold, we did go into the observatory, and just as we had hoped, there was an upstairs, and a downstairs, and the lower level was like unto an house. Yea, there was a table, and a bed, and a place to wash, and a grand window overlooking the sea.

6. And now, this place was most spacious, and was finely built, being fit for noble and elect Gods.

7. And behold, we did also go up stairs, and did see that I was correct in my assumption. For lo, there was a great telescope; and the glass ceiling, that was shaped as a dome did come down, even unto the floor, therefore, the whole sky was unabstructed; and I did see one of the planets or moons that was currently close unto us, and behold it was yellow with orange and red spots and lines, and did verily look like unto brimstone, and did appear to be very hot.

8. Now, we did return to the lower level, and Gartharah did convince me to do as she had instructed before, and I did place mine raiment into a drawer.

9. And now, we did see another book upon the table, and we did read a Revelation from it, and it did say, Not by way of commandment, but by admonition, and as a token of love for thy God Hayah; show not urination casually if ye are a male, nor put on thy trousers while sitting down as a male, for the image of the peacock is the image that is symbolic of thy God. pray for it. When ye marry; bop your wife on the head with a loaf of soft bread; and forget not the wife price, for that is a commandment. She should visit all the shrines on her way to thine house, for I am in all the imaginations of mine elect, whether they are accurate or not. Even so, Amen!

11. And now, Garthanah did find some food in this house also, and she bringeth me a loaf of bread and saith, Mananiah, ye should follow these things, so here is the bread, we already visited the shrine on the way here.

12. Now, I Mananiah did say, But Garthanah, you mean we are getting married? Wherefore, she saith, we already are.

13. Now I did say, What meaneth thee? She saith, I am free from the law of my father, I have never known a man, because of my translation I still have the tokens of my virginity, I love thee, and we are stuck on the same ship in Space, in the same way Adam, and Eve were stuck in the Garden of Eden; and ye wonder if we are married? Now bop me with the bread, seeing that we have already been to the shrine of Hayah.

14. Wherefore, I did lightly place the loaf upon her head, and after that we did lay down in bed, and I did pull her against mine self.

15. And now, She saith, I think that I am your Iuh counterpart as well! I covenant to be thine friend and sister forever! In Benbanuh's name, Amen!

THUS ENDS MANANIAH
